

Scholarships at Algonquin College:

1. **The Sherrylyn Sarazin Scholarship** (\$2,000) awarded annually to a second year First Nations, Métis or Inuit student enrolled in a diploma course who shows financial need and a good academic standing.
2. **The Susan B. Davies Scholarship in Nursing** (\$2,000) awarded annually to a second year First Nations, Métis, or Inuit student, preferably a female, who has achieved the highest GPA in the Practical Nursing Program. Awarded from 2019/2020 – 2024/2025.
3. **The HOPE Bursary for Refugee Women** (\$2,000) awarded annually to a 2nd or 3rd year female student in a diploma program who is – in order of preference – a convention refugee, a protected person, or a permanent resident who was a refugee/protected person, who demonstrates financial need and is in good academic standing. In the first year (2022) preference is for the bursary to be given to a female student from Afghanistan.
4. **University Women Helping Afghan Women Legacy Bursary** (\$1,000) awarded annually to a 2nd, 3rd or 4th year female Afghan student in any diploma or degree program who is – in order of preference – a convention refugee, a protected person, a permanent resident or Canadian citizen who was a refugee/protected person and who demonstrates financial need and is in good academic standing. Endowed in 2022 by the University Women Helping Afghan Women Interest Group of CFUW-Ottawa.
